STUDENTS SELECTED TO PARTICIPATE MUST:

- Have reliable transportation
- Be in an approved job shadow position and/ or be employed by 6/5
- Work an average of 20 hours per week (some flexibility due to vacations)
- Complete virtual lessons via Google Classroom once a week to help develop beneficial skills to succeed in the workplace.
- Students who successfully complete the program by completing all classwork and work for 120 hours will earn a stipend of \$1,600 & 1.0 Carnegie Credit in CTE Internship

EXAMPLES OF INTERNSHIP PLACEMENT:

- Students may job-shadow OR be employees. Students may not work for a family-owned business.
- IBC in Health Science: Clinic, Medical Facility, Pharmacy, Lab, etc.
- IBC in Skill Craft: Construction Company, Work with a Contractor, etc.
- IBC in IT or Media: Printshop, Graphic Design Company, IT Department,
 etc.
- IBC in Automotive: Bus Shop, Car Dealership, Automotive Shop, etc.
